



Tropical Cyclone Alfred and Western Queensland Floods (March – May 2025)

Eligible Local Government Areas (LGA's) – Current as at 03 March 2026

Below is a list of remote, rural and regional LGA's that have been declared as affected by Tropical Cyclone Alfred and Western Queensland Storms and Floods from 1 March to 19 May 2025.

FRRR will use this list to inform eligibility, but it will not be the only basis on which an application is assessed and prioritised. If you believe that you are in a storm and flood-affected community that is not in a metro area and whose LGA is not listed here, call us on 1800 170 020 to discuss the situation.
